Sun Cup Regulations, Florida 2025

40th EDITION

The 40th edition of the Sun Cup tournament presents a strict set of rules to ensure a fair and exciting event. This document details the guidelines for players participating in the tournament.

Conduct and Penalties

Prohibited Contact

No contact between players is allowed during matches.

Major Penalties

10-minute penalties lead to immediate expulsion from the game. Fighting results in tournament expulsion and a 5-minute major penalty.

Penalty Times

All penalties, whether 2, 5, or 10 minutes, are continuous time and not timed.

Any player, instructor, or representative who confronts a referee or any other Tournament official will be automatically banned from the Tournament.

Player and Official Responsibilities

Arena Attendance

Players must arrive 60 minutes before each game.

Mandatory Equipment

Protective helmets are required for all players during games.

Tournament Officials

All referees and officials are selected by the tournament organization, and their decisions are final.

Match Structure

Match Composition

Each match consists of 3 periods of 15 minutes running time, except for the last 2 minutes which may be timed if there is a one-goal differential.

No Time-Outs

There are no time-outs during matches.
Games proceed without interruption.

Points

2 points for a victory
1 point for a draw

Clearances

There will be no centre line.

Slap Shots Allowed

Specific Tournament Rules

Finals Eligibility

To participate in the semi-final or final, all players must have played at least two games with the team during the tournament.

Penalties for Violations

Violation of rules may result in immediate disqualification.

Rule Modifications

Hockey International reserves the right to modify regulations without notice, at its discretion.

Qualification and Tiebreaker Procedures

Head-to-Head Victory

In case of a double tie, the team that won against the other will qualify.

The maximum GF during a game will be 7 goals.

Goals Against

If there is a three-way tie, GA will be favoured, if there is still a tie, the differential between the GF and GA will determine who passes

Tournament Venue and Environment



Arena Boca Ice

Teams must vacate the locker rooms 30 minutes after their game.



Locker Room Rules

No beer cases are allowed in the locker rooms during the tournament.



Property Security

The organization is not responsible for items lost or stolen during the event.
